HTIP Support for Alberta SMEs

- EDT Grant with strategic objective to enable Alberta SMEs to obtain global market access
- SME Support:
 - Education – SMEs & supporting innovation ecosystem
 - Protocol development support
 - Development of a toolkit with methodologies and economic models that extrapolate analyses in the Alberta context to other jurisdictions
- IHE Services Support:
